

***CCP 216: The Role of Scripture and Liturgy in Catholic Faith Formation***

***Final Exam:***

*Your Final Exam will consist of five questions (I will give you eight to prepare...you select five—must choose number 8). These short essay responses will be no longer than 2-3 paragraphs. The final exam is to exercise your knowledge of the faith as it would be lived, catechized and evangelized. Again, carefully consider the essentials to the question to better prepare for a clear and concise response. Godspeed!*

- 1) Using examples from classroom discussion and notes, explain to me the importance of the following quote: “*Scriptures are liturgical documents of the OT and NT*”—*Caroll Stuhmueller*. In what way is this statement apologetic? Consider how church history gives an essential perspective into conversion.

Consult week 1: Key terms and Heading I

- 2) Define freedom and the Moral law as discussed in class. Why is this so pertinent to the essence of worship? What was so problematic with William Ochkam’s theory and what are its permutations in today’s culture?

Consult week 2: Headings IV and V

- 3) Reflecting upon Danielou, Corbon and classroom discussion, explain to me what is meant by Paul’s phrase “put on Christ” in relationship to Baptism (Gal.3:27)? What is the sphragis and its relationship in belonging to Christ?

Consult week 4: Headings X and XI

- 4) Reflecting upon Ratzinger’s *Feast of Faith* and classroom discussion, define the structure and content of prayer? What is the relationship between prayer and faith? Consider the following phrase: “*We are called to reproduce the image of Christ*”

Consult week 3: Headings VI and VII

- 5) Why is Understanding the Feast of Pentecost so essential to the Christian journey? Consider the vision of both the Old and New Testament.

Consult week 5: Heading XIII and Week 6: Heading XVI

- 6) Why is the Resurrection so central to our faith?

Consult week 7

- 7) Define for me Rite and Ritual. Why is it imperative to prepare for Mass and actively participate in the Introductory Rite? Consider how we might be better disposed to receive the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist?

Consult week 9: Headings XXV and word of the week on Mercy (cf. classroom notes)

- 8) Setting: Liturgy Committee in the upstairs meeting room.

Circumstance: You have just arrived for your first Liturgy meeting in which you know just a few members. Your Pastor poses an opening question after prayer.

Pastoral Question (Priest): *“How can we strengthen authentic worship in our local parish that is faithful to the magisterium?”*

Response from member of liturgy Committee: *“We need to be sure to have a pancake breakfast after every morning Mass and not be so concerned about overwhelming the people with rubrics.”*

Your response to the group:
