

***From the Pastor's Desk***

As I mentioned in late November, a project has been proposed to replace the Stations of the Cross inside the church. The stations that we have presently are not the original ones from 1910 when our church was dedicated. They were installed in the church sometime after 1966 when a rather radical transformation to the church interior was completed. With our current stations, it is difficult to tell which stage of the way of the cross each station depicts. It is my hope that we can install stations that are more vibrant and that show clearly the way of the cross and help foster a deeper devotion to praying the Stations of the Cross. So far, I have presented the project to the Finance Council, Parish Council and the Liturgy Committee and there is openness to the idea.

We are considering purchasing stations composed by the artist Leonard Porter. The Stations can be reviewed on the internet at [www.segnatura.com](http://www.segnatura.com) Presently, a copy of the Fourth Station is mounted on the south wall of the church. A full set of Stations will cost \$20,000.
